Origin Spotlight - Norway



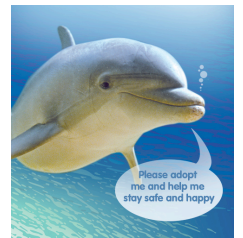
Norwegian Viking Coffee, named after the fierce Vikings, first appeared in the 8th Century. Viking sailors were known to insist on massive amounts of coffee to fuel their bodies for the long days endured at sea. As you can see from the image above, you would not want to deny these people their high energy beverage. The coffee is grown today much as it was in ancient times, in earthen mud green houses primarily as a way of keeping the tradition of Norse coffee alive. Since it is a crop of tradition and not meant as a cash export crop, it is extremely rare. We obtained our single 70 kilogram bag of these prized beans by trading a quantity of our ceramic King David Coffee mugs to a lone Viking who took a wrong turn and ended up outside our door on the Merrimack river. We pointed him in a southerly direction and last saw him rowing toward Massachusetts to make his way back to
